In line with new Government requirements, we have ensured that we do not have more than three items of branded uniform, in fact we only require one item! All other items of uniform are readily available in all supermarkets or others for affordable prices. Our uniform supplier for branded items is CJI Clothing based in Moordown, Bournemouth.

Please ensure all logo jumpers and PE jumpers are named. Remember everyone wears the same and returning lost items is not possible if it is not named. All children are expected to wear the following uniform;

All year groups

- Navy sweatshirt / cardigan with school logo
- White polo shirt or white shirt with proper collar
- Black or grey trousers / skirt / pinafore / shorts
- Blue & white checked dress (summer term)
- White, black or grey socks / tights
- Flat black shoes (not boots or trainers)

PE Kit All year groups

PE Kit is worn from home into school on the allocated PE days.

- Navy/Black tracksuit – not hoodies
- Plain white t-shirt – no logos
- Black or navy-blue shorts / jogging bottoms
- Dark coloured trainers
- White, black or grey socks

Any other sports clothing and/or trainers are not acceptable. For example, football kits, coloured t-shirts, leggings, hoodies etc. should not be worn.

Jewellery

- Stud earrings only. These must be removed by your child or prior to school on PE days. This avoids injury during PE sessions.
- If children do not remove jewellery for PE class teachers reserve the right to ask children to sit out of PE if they believe the jewellery poses a risk to the child or others.
- Small watch, no smart watches.
- No other jewellery is permitted.

Make-up

No make up or nail varnish can be worn in school, and children will be asked to remove it as soon as possible.

Hair Colour

No hair dye is appropriate or acceptable.
